A gift from God through which He blesses His children.


Only received in temples.

Two parts

- Initiatory
- Endowment

Initiatory

Initiatory = Washing, Anointing & Clothing

Exodus 29:4-9

It includes special blessings related to the person's divine heritage and potential.

Tabernacle of Moses (Ex. 40:12)

And thou shalt bring Aaron and his sons unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and wash them with water.

Tabernacle of Moses (Ex: 40:13)

And thou shalt put upon Aaron the holy garments, and anoint him, and sanctify him; that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Initiatory

Clothing with the garment

- We are authorized to wear the temple garment.
- It represents our personal relationship with God and commitment to obey covenants made in the temple.
- If we are faithful to our covenants and wear the garment properly throughout our lives, it also serves as a protection.

- Law of Consecration dedication of time, talents, and all things given by the Lord to build up the Church on the earth.


God Promises

Sealing of Wife and Husband

To join husband and wife together for time and eternity if they are faithful to the covenants made in the temple.



Couples who are sealed are promised glory and joy throughout eternity.

Children may also be part of the eternal family.

See D&C 132:19-20

Sealing of Children

Children born to parents sealed in a temple are born in the covenant of that sealing.

Children not born in the covenant can become part of an eternal family by being sealed to their birth or adoptive parents and are entitled to the same blessings as those who were born in the covenant.



Temple Garments



As part of the endowment, we covenant to wear the garment throughout our lives.

It's an outward expression of our inner commitment to follow the Savior.

The garment is a reminder of temple covenants.

When worn properly throughout life, it will serve as a protection.

Temple Garments



Worn beneath the outer clothing

Should not be removed for activities that can reasonably be done while wearing the garment.

Should not be modified to accommodate different styles of clothing.

Temple Garments



The garment is sacred and should be treated with respect.

Endowed members should seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit to answer personal questions about wearing the garment.
